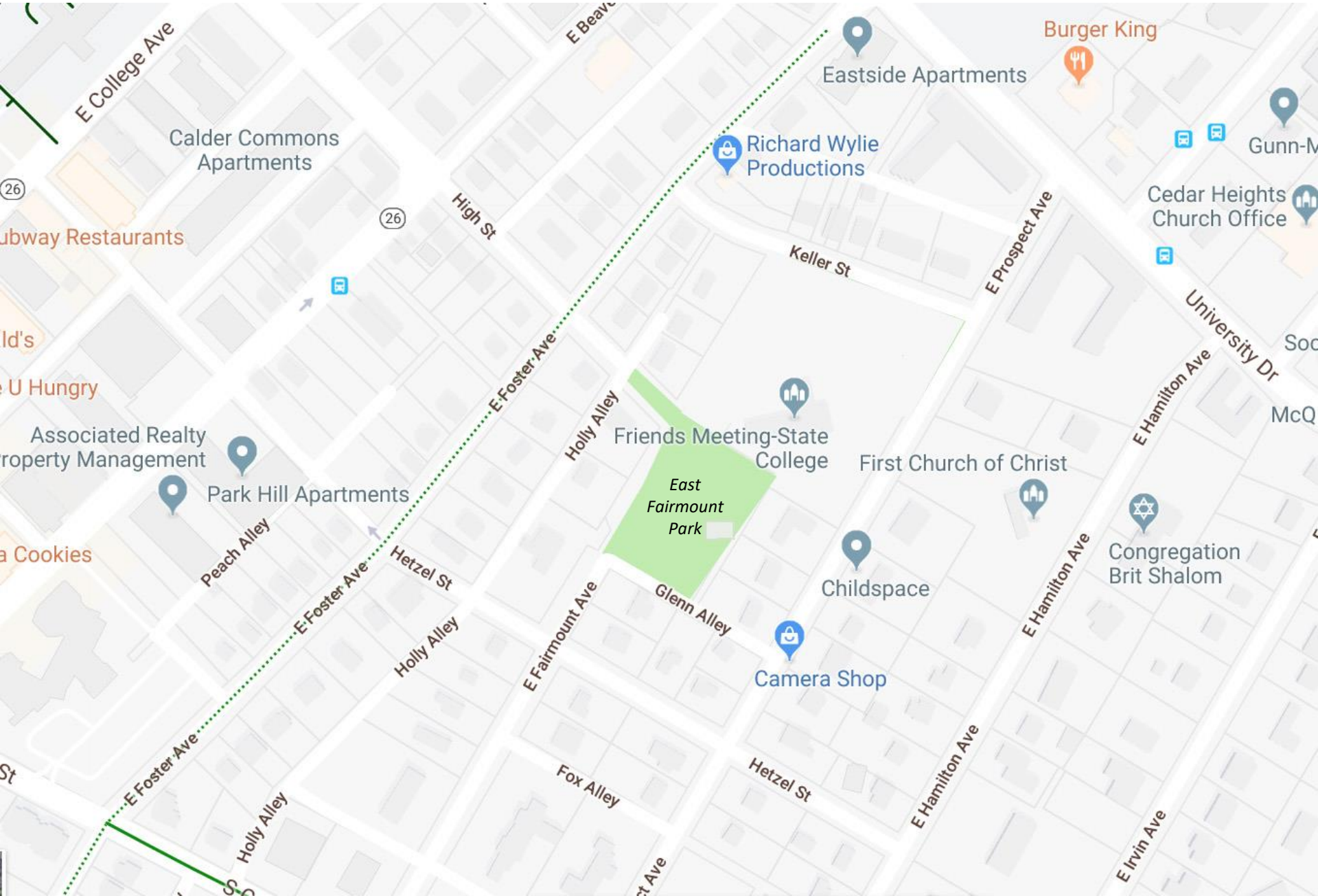

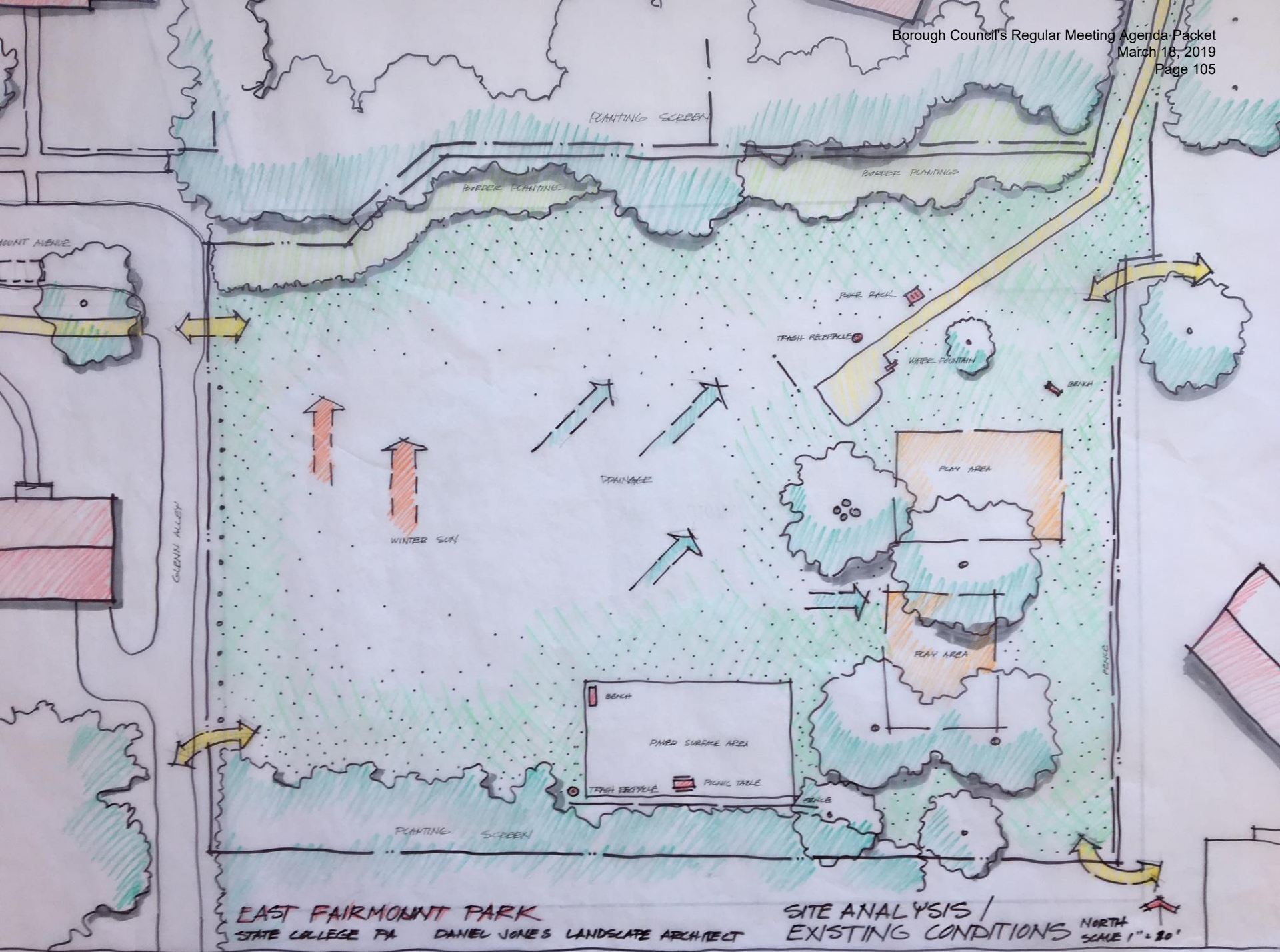

Evaluation of Existing Conditions by the Landscape Architect





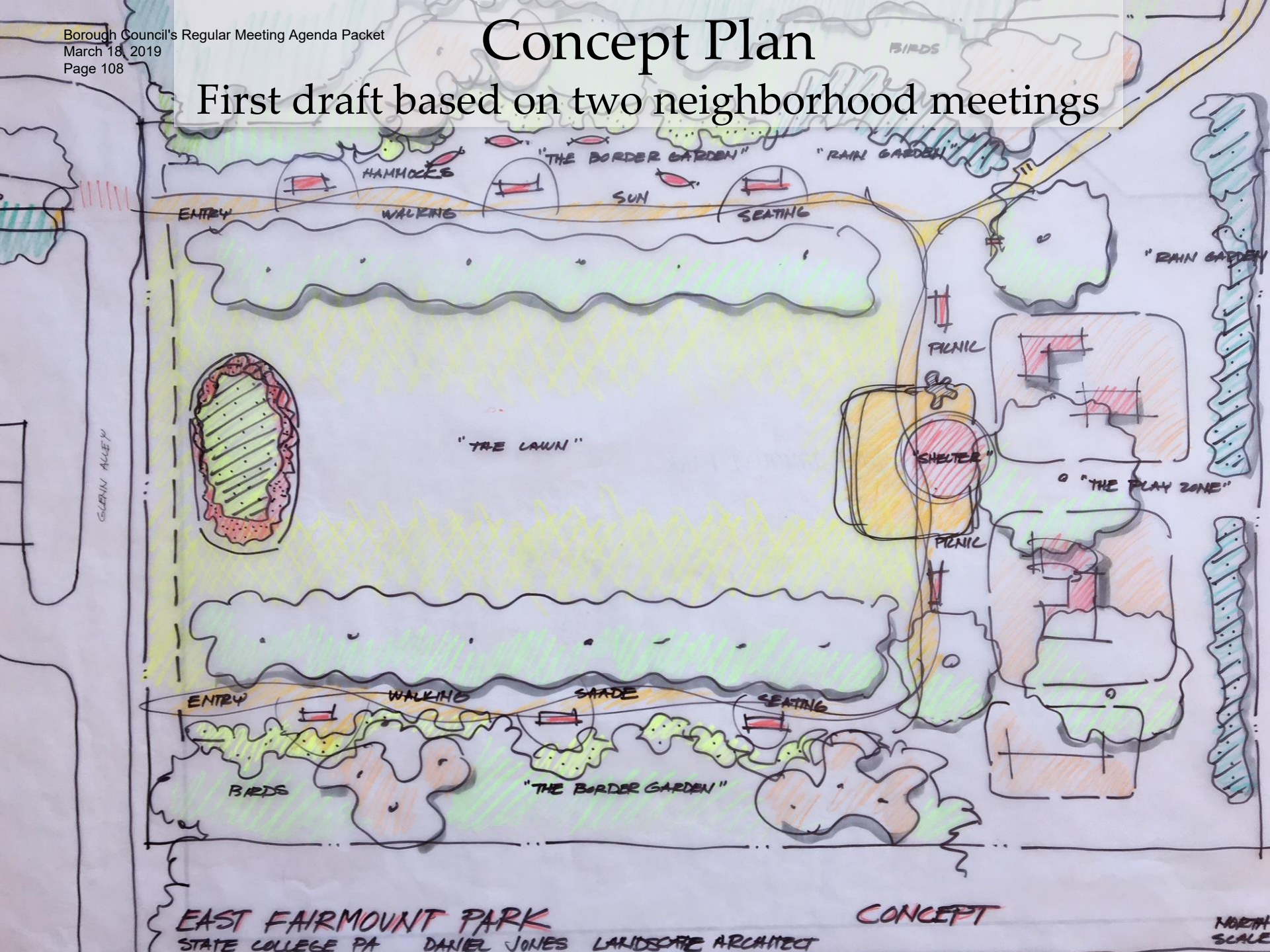

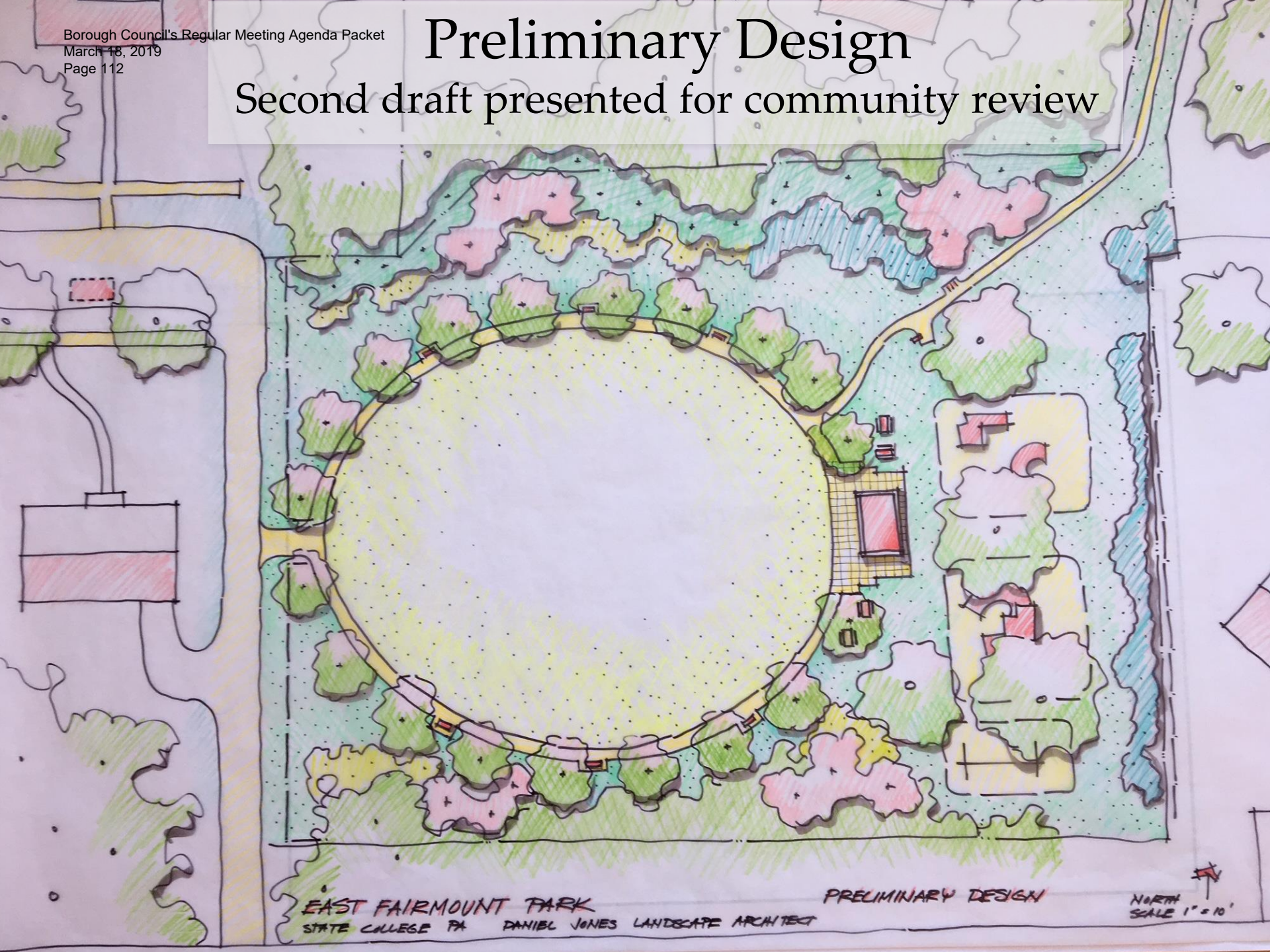

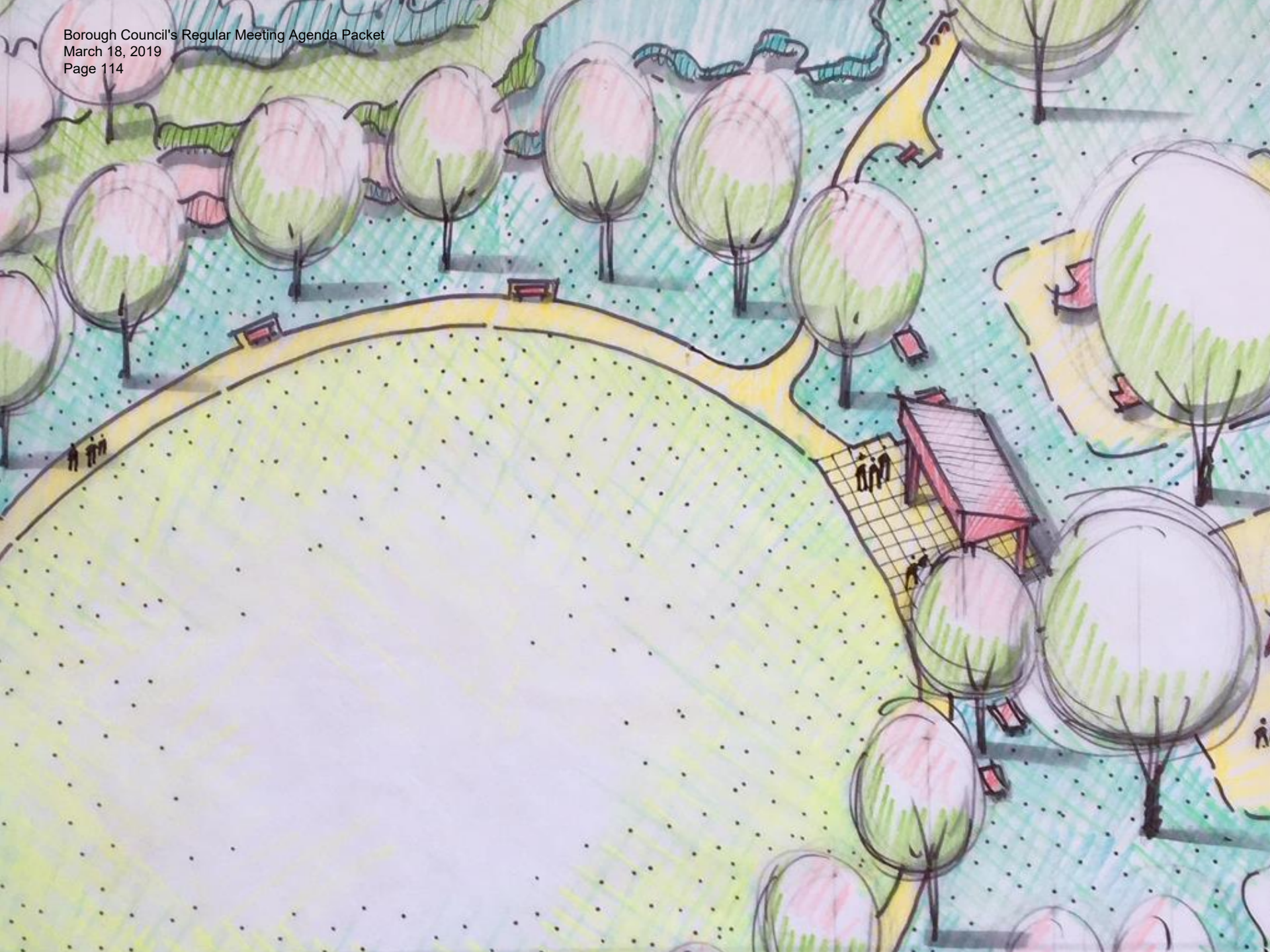

PRELIMINARY DESIGN

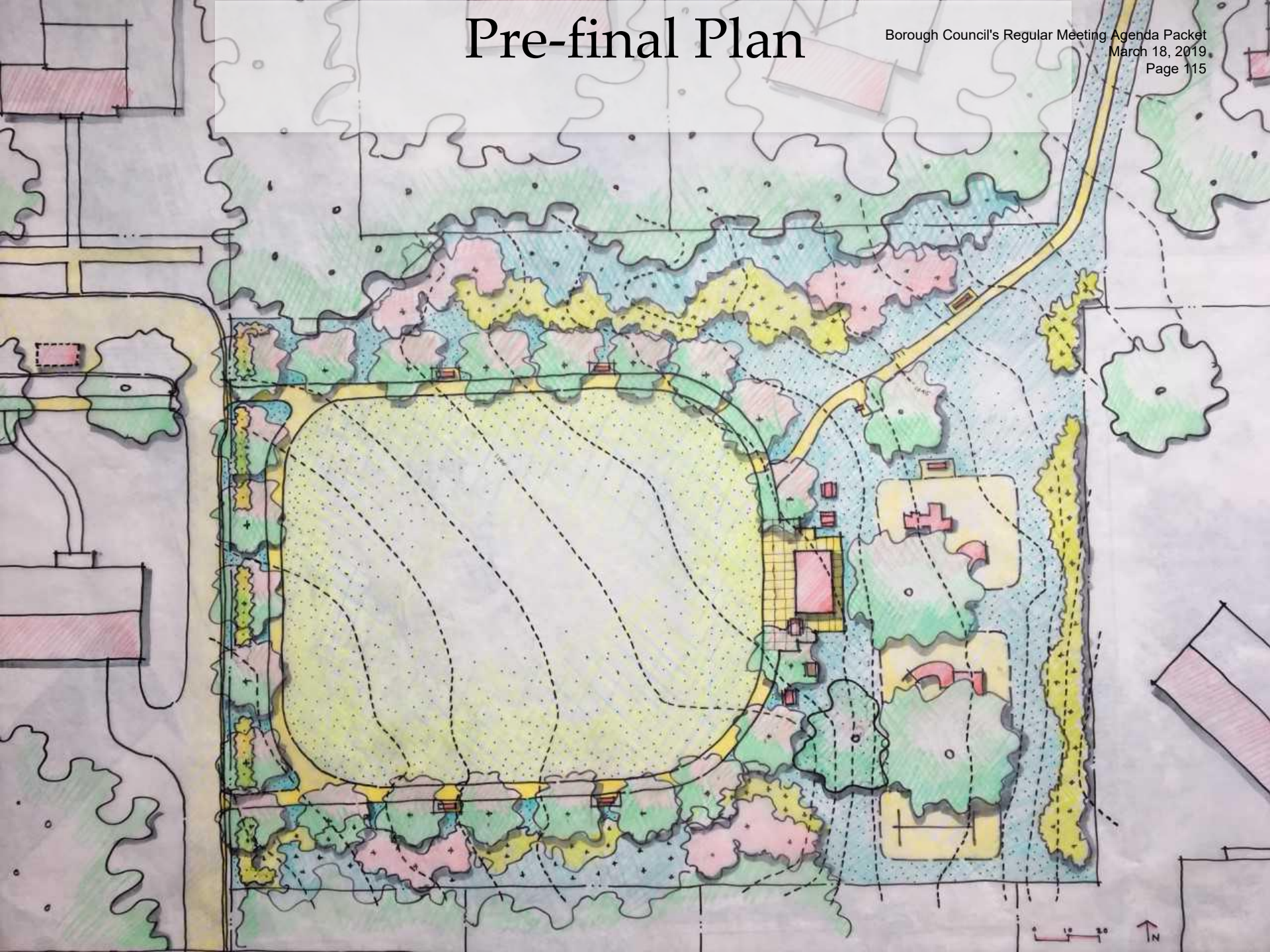

- Total Estimated Project Cost: \$165,000
